It's almost time for you to say good-bye to high school and begin the journey toward becoming a TCU alumnus. We are so excited about your arrival to campus in August and are already making preparations that will help you make TCU your home away from home.

We are finalizing details on the Housing Application and want to make you aware of a few important reminders before you can tell us about yourself. We will not be taking hall preferences, with a few exceptions.

1. We will take preferences for an all-female or co-ed residence hall.
2. If you are an Honors student, you will be able to indicate your preference to live in Milton Daniel.
3. If you are willing and interested in living in an extended triple room, you will be able to indicate that on your survey. Our office will then contact you about your first choice of residence hall. Triples will be filled as space is available.

The Housing Application link will be open between May 1 and May 25 via my.tcu.edu. Changes can be made at any time during those days and the date you submit your Housing Application does not determine your assignment priority.

The following items must be submitted before you can access the Housing Application link:

1. \$500 non-refundable Tuition Deposit
2. \$400 non-refundable Housing Deposit
3. Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination Records (for information, visit: www.healthcenter.tcu.edu)

To optimize your move-in experience in August, we encourage you to attend a June Orientation, especially if you are participating in Panhellenic Sorority Recruitment. Attending a June Orientation will allow you to maximize your time spent with all the Panhellenic chapters during the formal Recruitment process.
